## STATEMENT BY MR. NOBUSHIGE TAKAMIZAWA AMBASSADOR EXTRAORDINARY AND PLENIPOTENTIARY PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF JAPAN TO THE CONFERENCE ON DISARMAMENT

The 1419<sup>th</sup> Plenary Meeting of the Conference on Disarmament Geneva, 30 May 2017

Mr. President,

Since this is the first time that I take the floor under your presidency, let me congratulate you, Ambassador Rosocha, on your assumption of the Presidency of the Conference. I assure you of my delegation's full support and cooperation towards the revitalization of the CD. I also would like to extend my warm welcome to Ambassador Kleib. We are looking forward to working with you in the CD and other disarmament fora.

## Mr. President,

Despite the repeated strong calls from the international community, yesterday on May 29th, the DPRK launched a ballistic missile again, in a clear violation of a series of United Nations Security Council Resolutions (UNSCRs) and against the Joint Statement of the Six-Party Talks. This year alone, the DPRK has launched at least twelve ballistic missiles and five of them including the yesterday's missile have reached Japan's exclusive economic zone (EEZ), which poses a serious danger for aviation and navigation. This provocative and dangerous behaviour by the DPRK is unacceptable.

The recent launches by the DPRK constitute a grave and increasing threat to the regional and international peace and security. We condemn the DPRK in the strongest terms and urge the DPRK to immediately and fully implement relevant UNSCRs and other commitments without taking further provocative actions. And also we strongly call on the international community to redouble its efforts to ensure the sustained, comprehensive, thorough and effective implementation of relevant UNSCRs.
