**Statement delivered by Minister NAMIOKA Daisuke, Deputy Permanent
Representative of Japan to the Conference on Disarmament
at the Preparatory Committee of the Seventh Review Conference of the
Convention on Certain Conventional Weapons
7 September 2026, Geneva, Switzerland**

Thank you, Mr. Chair,

It is important that the CCW be more widely recognised as a framework that contributes to peace and stability in the international community through the appropriate use of conventional weapons in accordance with international law.

Recognising that the development of international humanitarian law has always gone hand in hand with efforts towards its universal acceptance and implementation, Japan supports efforts to promote the universalisation of the CCW, so that more States join the CCW framework and its implementation is further advanced worldwide.
